

KAT Snow Route Information

Regular Snow Routes

When winter weather makes roads dangerous for driving, KAT buses will run on Snow Routes; Snow Routes are slightly altered routes that keep our passengers moving and safe.

The chart on the next page is a list of each KAT route and how that route is affected when we are running on Regular Snow Routes.

If the weather is bad, just tune into your local radio station or TV channel to find out if KAT is currently operating on Snow Routes. You can also call us at 637-3000. Severe Conditions Snow Routes

If the weather gets really bad, KAT starts running on “Severe Conditions Snow Routes.” When this happens, service will be provided ONLY on the major corridors of Knoxville:

Kingston Pike (to Peters Road), Chapman Highway (to Chapman Plaza), Magnolia Avenue (to Chilhowee Dr.), Broadway (to Essary), Central Avenue (to Woodland), and Western Avenue (to I-640 Plaza). **See the last page of this pdf for more specific routing information for Severe Conditions Snow Routes.**

During Severe Conditions, all passengers ride free. Please note: If KAT is able to upgrade back to Regular Snow Routes before your return trip, you will be required to pay regular fare for that portion of the trip.

KAT Snow Route Information

The following information applies *only* when KAT is on *Regular Snow Routes*. If road conditions warrant moving to Extreme/Severe Conditions Snow Routes, please use the information on the next page of this pdf instead.

KAT Snow Route Information

Severe Conditions Snow Routes

The following route information applies ONLY when KAT is operating on Severe Conditions Snow Routes. For Regular Snow Route information, see the table on the previous page.

If the weather gets really bad, KAT starts running on "Severe Conditions Snow Routes." When this happens, service will be provided ONLY on the major corridors of Knoxville. This includes:

Route 11: Kingston Pike-- Bypasses mall. From Kingston Pike--takes Right on Galaher View, Left on Walbrook, Left on Walker Springs back to Kingston Pike for return trip.

Route 12: Western Avenue-- Stays on Western Avenue. From Hall of Fame, turns on Summit Hill, continues onto Western Avenue. Left on Ed Shouse, Right on Copper Kettle, then Right back to Western Avenue for return trip.

Route 20: Central Avenue-- Only goes as far as Woodland Avenue. Turns Right on Woodland, Right on Broadway, Left on Central, Left on Fifth and Right on Hall of Fame.

Route 22: Broadway--Goes as far as the Fountain City Superstop on Knox Road, then returns to downtown (does not operate on Essary Drive, Jacksboro Pike and Garden Drive).

Route 31: Magnolia--Only goes as far as Kirkwood. From Magnolia, turns Right on Lakeside, Left on MLK, Left on Kirkwood then Left on Magnolia for return trip.

Route 41: Chapman Highway--regular routing

During Severe Conditions, all passengers ride free. Please note: IF KAT has upgraded back to Regular Snow Routes or regular routing before your return trip home, you will be required to pay the fare for the return trip.
