

Knoxville Area Transit D.O.T.
Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal for FY 2012-2014

Knoxville Area Transit has established a goal of 2% of Federal financial assistance to be expended in DOT-assisted contracts in federal fiscal years 2012-2014 [exclusive of Federal Transit Administration funds to be used for the purchase of transit vehicles] to be spent with firms who are certified as Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) under Department of Transportation regulations (49 CFR Part 26) . Knoxville Area Transit will meet its goal by advertising bid opportunities through the City of Knoxville Purchasing website, as well as in a timely manner in DBE and general circulation publications and by advising City Purchasing at the time of requisition of possible DBE vendors.
